

The 11th Country Focused Training Course on the Juvenile Delinquent Treatment System for Kenya

1. Duration and Participants

From 15 February to 11 March 2011

Fifteen participants from government agencies involved in juvenile justice:

Dept. of Children's Services; Ministry of Gender, Children and Social Development; Dept. of Probation and Aftercare Services; Dept. of Prisons; Office of the Vice President and Ministry of Home Affairs; Kenyan Police Service; and the judiciary.

2. Programme Overview

Since October 2009, JICA has provided the Kenyan Government with technical assistance in, "Child Care and Protection Officer Training (CCPO Training)." This project aims to establish a scheme of capacity building for officers of juvenile justice agencies.

In this Course, to promote the project, participants are to:

- Review the contents of the pilot CCPO training programme (the curriculum, its delivery methodologies, training manuals and modules, all of which have been implemented on a trial basis so far).
- Through lectures and field trips, to understand what it takes to treat juveniles under the juvenile justice system.
- Recommend revisions to the current curriculum and manuals for the CCPO training programme and build action plans to improve same.
