

UNAFEI's 175th International Training Course (Online)
"Treatment of Women Offenders"

1. Duration and Participants

From 26 October to 11 November

21 overseas participants from 11 jurisdictions

2. Programme Overview

This programme will focus on the treatment of women offenders, aiming to enhance knowledge and understanding on gender-responsive offender treatment in the community and in prisons by taking into account the gender-specific needs of women offenders.

3. Programme Format

Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, the programme is being conducted online. To account for the time differences and work duties of each participant, lectures were video-recorded in advance, and the participants will watch them on-demand. We will divide the participants into two groups, and each group will have live Q&A sessions with lecturers, discussions and individual presentations online. At the end of the programme, participants are required to present their action plans to enhance or improve the treatment of women offenders in each jurisdiction based on what they have learned throughout the programme.
