- Participants who participate in the entire curriculum (except for the observation visit) will receive a certificate.

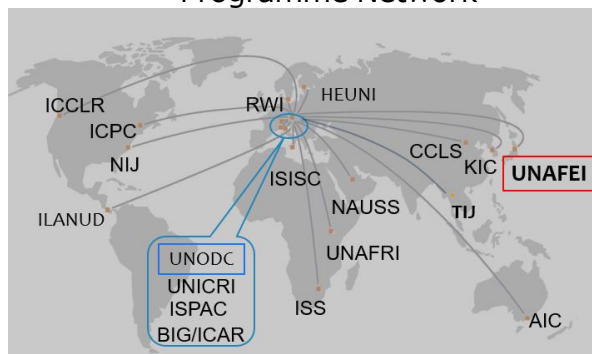




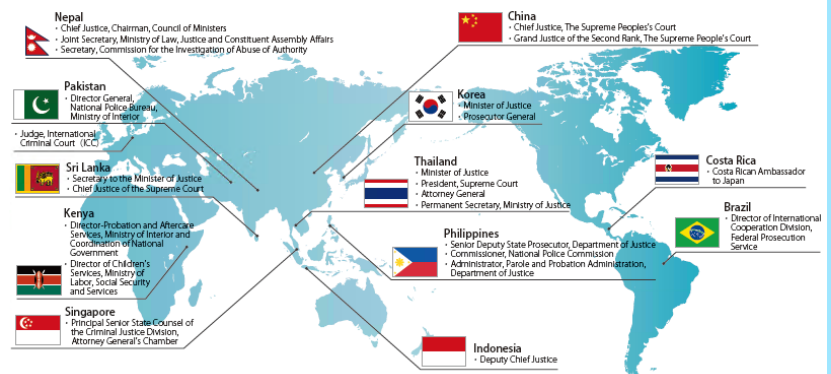
UNAFEI: United Nations Asia and Far East Institute for the Prevention of Crime and the Treatment of Offenders

The UN Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice Programme Network



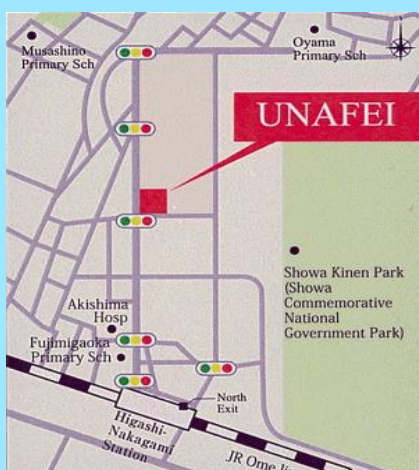
UNAFEI alumni around the world
